The **Definitive Anaesthetic Trauma Care** (DATC<sup>™</sup>) course is developed under the auspices of the Portuguese Steering Committee of the International Association for Trauma Surgery and Intensive Care (IATSIC).

The DATC™ is an intensive course comprising pre-course online-lectures, lectures, interactive case discussions and trauma management simulation, designed to teach qualified anaesthesiologists and advanced anaesthesia trainees, knowledge, skills, strategic thinking and decision-making in the management of the severely injured patients.

The DATC™ course runs simultaneously with the Definitive Surgical Trauma Care course (DSTC™) course for surgeons and the Definitive Perioperative Nurses Trauma Care (DPNTC™) course for nurses.

DATC™ candidates participate in lectures, interactive case discussions and live animal session with their DSTC™ colleagues, re-enacting a trauma operating room.

The slides are in English but the lectures will be presented in English, Portuguese or in Spanish. The case discussions will be in English.
